Scottish Target Shooting would like to invite you to the Denwood Range, Aberdeen on Sunday 11 July 2021. We are running this Prone event to give you the opportunity to have a shoot.

Programme

Open Competition

The meeting is a 50m squadded smallbore (.22) prone rifle event that is run on electronic targets with decimal scoring. The competition is run in 4 classes and comprises of 60 competition shots to be fired in 50min. This is preceded by a 15min setup period and a 15min preparation and sighting period.

There will be 10 lanes available per relay due to Covid-19 restrictions.

Competition Dates

The event will be held on Sunday, 11 July 2021 at the Denwood Range.

Event Rules

The shoot will be run under NSRA rules except cross-shots will be scored as misses. The Range Jury will consist of three people from the local organising committee and/or the STS Smallbore AMG.

Equipment storage

Due to COVID protocols, shooters are encouraged to make their own arrangements for storing equipment where possible.

Please note that it has been necessary to restrict visitor use of the Armoury at Denwood to storage of rifles and ammunition only. These must be in locked cases or boxes. Mats and bags will not be allowed in the Armoury but space will be made available for them to be left within the building.

Also, as part of several measures being taken to improve the security of the facility for all users, an automatic closer has been fitted on the Armoury door.

There will always be someone at the range who can open the Armoury but competitors should be aware that they may be shooting and make due allowance.
