2022-23 Pistol Winter Postal Competition

Programme

This is a postal competition with 8 rounds to be shot between November and May 2023.

There are three weeks between each round shoot-by dates. Scores and results should be submitted within two weeks of the shoot-by date.

Shooters with a Disability –

Since the competition rounds are shot at your regular range or club, the Pistol postal competitions are open to shooters with a disability.

Unless otherwise stated, the firing position is free standing. (No part of the upper body may come into contact with any part of the lower body or any item used as a rest)

Your Health and Safety

Your health and safety are a priority with Scottish Target Shooting (STS) and we ask that you comply with all health and safety measures in place at your range or club.

Prizes

- A Gold medal will be awarded to the overall winner of the competition
- A Silver medal will be awarded to the competitor in 2nd place

Competitions

- **10m Air Pistol 60 shot** – 5 shots on each of 12 targets per round shot on Air 4/89-18 or ISSF targets
- **10m Air Pistol 30 shot** – 5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on Air 4/89-18 or ISSF targets
- **10m Sport Air Pistol 30 shot** – 5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on Air 4/89-18 or ISSF targets 15 shots precision 15 timed
- **10m Air Rifle 30 shot** – 1 shot on each diagram 5 diagrams per card of 6 targets per round shot on Air 3/89-18, 2/89-18 or ISSF targets
- **25m/20yd Long Range Air Pistol** - 10 shots on each of 3 targets per round shot on S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards
- **25m/20yd Muzzle Loading Pistol** – 13 shots, best 10 to count on PL7-18 at 25 metres or PL12-18 at 20 yards
- **25m/20yd Muzzle Loading Revolver** – 13 shots, best 10 to count on PL7-18 at 25 metres or PL12-18 at 20 yards
- **25m/20yd Long Barrelled Pistol/Revolver** – 5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards
- **25m/20yd Free Pistol** – 5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards
- **25m/20yd Sport Rifle Precision** – 10 shots on each of 3 targets per round shot on S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards
- **25m/20yd Sport Rifle Standard** – 2 series of 5 shots in 150 seconds 2 series of 5 shots in 20 seconds 2 series of 5 shots in 10 seconds S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards
- **25m/20yd Gallery Rifle Precision** – 4 series of 5 shots per series on DP 1, S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards
- **25m/20yd Gallery Rifle Timed and Precision** – 25 metres - 12 Shots in 5 minutes (to include re-loading), 15 metres - 12 shots in 2 strings of 6, 1 shot per 2 second exposure, 10 metres - 6 shots, 2 shots per 3 second exposure on DP 2 targets

Stickers

Stickers will be posted out to each entrant and you should receive the correct number of stickers for your competition entries. Please check and advise us if you think the stickers you receive are incorrect by emailing events@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk

- **Before shooting**, place a sticker on the middle of the rear of each target and write your name, competition, and round number on the front of the target. (**Electronic Targets: Please affix all stickers to the printout.**)
- **After shooting**, cards and electronic target print outs should be signed, witnessed by a club officer and dated.

Submitting Your Scores

Further details on how to submit your scores will be issued before the first round.

Cards DO NOT need to be returned UNLESS requested - you may be asked to return cards for random checks (or in the event of a challenge) so keep cards for a minimum of two months after the 'Submit by' date.

If you need to return cards you will be asked by email to do so within six weeks of the return date (eight weeks of the shoot-by date) and you will have two weeks to return them (if on holiday or exceptional circumstances this can be extended).

If a returned card is checked and a minor error is found, the recorded score will be updated. If a major discrepancy is found, or the card is not returned, further investigation will occur, and scores may be voided.

You can anonymously challenge a score someone else has submitted by emailing Scottish Target Shooting at events@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk with the competitor name, event and round you are challenging. Organisers may then request the shot card to be returned if within the timescales stated above
