



Scottish Target Shooting

10m Air Rifle Winter Grand Prix 2023-24

Programme

A series of five 10m Air Rifle events run on electronic targets. The main competition is run in 4 classes and comprises of 60 competition shots to be fired in 1hour 15minutes. This is preceded by a 10 minute setup period and a 15 minute preparation and sighting period.

Competition Dates

Event Rules

The Grand Prix will be run as far as possible under ISSF rules with equipment control advice available at each event. Equipment control rules may be waived in the lower classes at the discretion of the event organiser.

The Range Jury will consist of any three people from the local organising committee and/or the STS Smallbore AMG.

Shooters with a Disability

Venue Accessibility

The Carlisle club and the indoor range at Denwood are accessible venues. The Alloa club is accessible with a steep ramp to the range. Wheelchair users may need a little extra help to negotiate this.

The Bunker in Inverness is not accessible for entrants with little or no lower limb mobility due to steps at the entrance.

Novices

Novices are very welcome at these events. While competing against some of the best shots in the country, this is a chance to enjoy the experience of competitive shooting, chat to a wide range of shooters, and, most of all, have some fun.

Your Health and Safety

Your health and safety are a priority with Scottish Target Shooting (STS) and we ask that you comply with all health and safety measures in place at the venue at the time of the event.

Extra Shoot

Subject to entry and range capacity the extra shoot is an optional additional 60 shot match. Places can only be requested and paid on the day for a fee of £5. Main Competition entries take precedence over "Extra Shoot" entries.

The winner of the "Extra Shoot" will be the competitor achieving the highest percentage increase in score from their main competition score and will receive a return of their entry fee for the extra shoot competition.

Final

Depending on range capacity and entry, the leading competitors after the qualifying match will shoot in an ISSF style final.

The winner will be the competitor with the highest match score in the final.

Points

Points for the Grand Prix series will be awarded based on the competitor's position in the final according to the table below. If the range does not have capacity to run an 8 lane final the competitors who would have qualified for an 8 lane final will be awarded points based on their qualification ranking.

No points will be awarded to competitors who qualify for the final but do not compete in the final.

Prizes

For each competition the following prizes will be awarded in each class;

- **Competitor in 1st place** Gold medal
- **Competitor in 2nd place** Silver medal
- **Competitor in 3rd place** Bronze medal

A further award will be made to the person with the most points at the end of the Grand Prix series.

In the situation that there is a tie for first place, then the number of first places, etc. in the series will be used to split the tie. If the tie cannot be split based on places then the average of all 60 shot matches shot in the series will be used.

Doping control

Scottish Target Shooting follows the doping regulations adopted by British Shooting, developed with UKAD. As such, the testing for banned substances may be carried out at any time. Please declare any medication at check-in before shooting.
