

All Ranges Open Meeting and Inter-Region Matches 20 April 2024

Denwood Range, Countesswells Road Aberdeen AB15 8AS

1. The All Ranges Open Meeting

The All Ranges Open Meeting comprises 40 shot competitions at each of 25 yards, 50 metres and 100 yards within an Aggregate.

Scores from the 50 metre and 100 yard competitions will be included as a Double Dewar.

Women, Juniors and Veterans

Additional competitions for Women, Juniors and Veterans will be held concurrent with the Aggregate. Choose the relevant entry when booking the Aggregate. Competitors must have entered Competitions 1, 2 and 3.

Juniors are entrants under the age of 21 on the day of the event. Veterans are entrants over the age of 60 on the day of the event.

Handicap Pairs

Each member of the pair must have entered Competitions 1, 2 and 3. Pair members do not have to be from the same club.

Handicap scores are:

Class A	Class B	Class C	Class D
Scratch	+8	+16	+24

Club Team Competitions

There are competitions for Teams of 3 competitors from the same club, subject to receiving a sufficient entries.

There will also be an inexpert team competition for teams with members in C and D classes. Each member of the team must have entered Competitions 1, 2 and 3.

For all team competitions, please email your team member names to the Organiser before the event at allranges@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk.

Or speak to the organiser on the day of the competition before your team member/s shoot.

Timetable

Details will start at 09.30 and continue on the hour and half hour on all ranges until 17:30 if required.

- At 25 yards, 2 targets to be shot during each half hour.
 Ten minutes will be allowed for each card.
- At 50 metres and 100 yards, 1 target to be shot in each half hour. Twenty minutes will be allowed for each card.
- For team entries, the team captain should ensure all team members arrive in time to complete the course of fire.







All Ranges Prizes

For the All Ranges Competitions, except Competition 3, medals will be awarded to 1st place only in each class.

For All Ranges Competition 3, medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd if there are 6 or more competitors in the class, to 1st and 2nd only if there are less than 6 but more than 3 competitors in the class and to 1st only if there are less than 3 competitors in the class.

2. Inter-Region Matches

The Inter-Region Match combines both a Short Range and Double Dewar Team Match based on scores achieved within the All Ranges Open Meeting.

Each Inter-Region Match is for teams of 5 or of 6 with the best 5 to count.

Teams from regions identified by their local NSRA association can enter the Inter-Region Matches. Where a region consists of more than one area please confirm your area with the Organiser before entering by emailing allranges@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk.

Team members for each Inter-Region Match need not be the same. All team members must have entered Competition 1 and/or 2.

Please email team member names to the Organiser at <u>allranges@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk</u> before the event or speak to the Organiser on the day of the competition before your team member/s shoot/s.

Inter-Region Match Trophies

- The Inter-Region Short Range Match Trophy will be shot concurrently with the 25 yard competition.
- The Inter-Region Double Dewar Match for the Bob Normand Trophy will be shot concurrently with the Double Dewar competition. *Robin to chase*

Inter-Region Match Prizes

Medals will be awarded to the winning teams. Runner-up team medals will be subject to sufficient entry.

Event Rules and Classification

The event will be run under NSRA rules. The Individual Competitions will take place in 4 classes.

Competitors who do not have an NSRA outdoor classification should submit their average of their most recent 10 indoor cards. Those with NSRA X classification will shoot in A class.

Classification will be based on averages as follows:
