# Scottish 50m Pistol Championships 2023 17 June 2023

Denwood Range, Countesswells Road Aberdeen AB15 8AS

## **Programme**

This is a 0.22 free pistol event. The Qualification round comprises 10 minutes setting up time, 15 minutes of unlimited sighting shots followed by 60 match shots in 1 hour and 30 minutes.

The top scores will proceed to the 24 shot final with the number of finalists depending on the entry but will not exceed a total of 8. Clarification will be given prior to the qualification relay.

(Please note: you must have a free pistol for this event. Borrowing a pistol is not allowed.

## **Firearms Certificate (FAC)**

All free pistols must conform to UK legislation. Therefore all entrants must hold a valid FAC for the free pistol being used. Please contact <a href="mailto:events@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk">events@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk</a> if in doubt prior to booking.

#### **GB Selection Event**

This competition is a GB selection event. All competitors scores will be sent to British Shooting.

#### **Event Rules**

This competition will be run under ISSF rules on electronic targets. In all relays, competitors must report to their firing point at their allotted time.

#### **Shooters with a Disability:**

## **Entry Eligibility**

Since this event is run following ISSF rules, in general it is not open to competitors with a disability unless the competitor is able to comply with the ISSF rules. Disabled entrants must be able to hold the pistol unsupported.

#### **Venue Accessibility**

The 50m range at Denwood is accessible to wheelchair/mobility impaired competitors with help from club members to negotiate the steep path to the range. An accessible toilet is available at the indoor range which has step free access.

#### **Doping Control**

Scottish Target Shooting follows the doping regulations adopted by British Shooting, developed with UKAD. As such, the testing for banned substances may be carried out at any time. Please declare any medication at check-in before shooting.

#### **Juries**

A competition jury will be appointed, consisting of ISSF or British Shooting licensed judges and/or members of the STS Pistol Association Management Group (PST AMG).

#### **Ties**

Ties will be resolved as per ISSF Rule 6.15.

#### **Protests**

ISSF protest rules will apply ISSF rule 6.16. The protest fee for the meeting will be posted with a supply of Competitor Protest Forms.

#### **Prizes**

The overall winner will be awarded a gold medal and the annual trophy.
