STS Summer Pistol Postal Competitions 2024

Programme

A series of postal competitions for individuals will be run over the summer months. These competitions are **open to both members and non-members of Scottish Target Shooting** (STS). The events scheduled to run in the Summer Pistol Postal Competition 2024 programme are:

Individual Competitions – Closing Date for Entries 20 May

10m Air Pistol 60 shot

• 5 shots on each of 12 targets per round shot on Air 4/89-18 or ISSF targets.

10m Air Pistol 30 shot

• 5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on Air 4/89-18 or ISSF targets.

10m Sport Air Pistol 30 shot

5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on Air 4/89-18 or ISSF targets 15 shots precision, 15 timed.

25m/20yd Long Range Air Pistol

5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards.

25m/20yd Muzzle Loading Pistol

13 shots, best 10 to count on PL7-18 at 25 metres or PL12-18 at 20 yards.

25m/20yd Muzzle Loading Revolver

13 shots, best 10 to count on PL7-18 at 25 metres or PL12-18 at 20 yards.

25m/20yd Long Barrelled Pistol/Revolver

• 5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards.

25m/20yd Free Pistol

• 5 shots on each of 6 targets per round shot on S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards.

25m/20yd Sport Rifle Precision

10 shots on each of 3 targets per round shot on S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards.

25m/20vd Sport Rifle Standard

• 2 series of 5 shots in 150 seconds 2 series of 5 shots in 20 seconds 2 series of 5 shots in 10 seconds S.P.A.1 or PL 19-18 at 25 metres, PL14-18 at 20 yards.

25m/20yd Gallery Rifle Precision Iron/Any Sights

4 series of 5 shots per series on PL7-18 or PL8-18 at 25 metres, PL12-18 at 20 yards.

Submitting Your Scores

- Submit scores online a link can be found on the **Pistol Summer Postal Results** page under the "**EVENTS**" tab.
- Cards DO NOT need to be returned UNLESS requested or you have no local official to check and score these.
- You may be asked to return cards (or printouts from electronic targets) for random checks, or in the event of a challenge, so please retain your cards for one month after the final 'Submit by' date.
- If you need to return cards, you will be asked by email and you will have two weeks to return the requested cards (this deadline can be extended for exceptional circumstances).
- If a returned card is checked and a minor error is found, the recorded score will be updated. If a major discrepancy is found, or the card is not returned, further investigation will occur, and scores may be voided.
- You can challenge a score someone else has submitted by emailing Scottish Target Shooting at events@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk with the competitor's name, event and round you are challenging. Organisers may then request the shot card to be returned if within the timescales stated above.

Stickers

- Stickers will be posted out to the named Match Secretary/contact and you should receive the correct number of stickers for your entries. Please check and advise us if you think the stickers you receive are incorrect by emailing events@scottishtargetshooting.co.uk
- **Before shooting**, a Club Official must affix these to the front of the correct target for the discipline and distance. The targets must be shot and witnessed by a Club Official. (**Electronic Targets**: Please affix all stickers to the printout)
- After shooting, cards and electronic target print outs should be checked and signed by a Club Official and dated.

Refunds & Cancellations

- If a competition is cancelled, all entries fees for that competition will be fully refunded.
- Entrants withdrawing from a competition after the closing date will not be entitled to a refund except in exceptional circumstances subject to the discretion of the STS Office.
- Entrants removed from a competition for failing to submit scores on time or failing to submit targets when requested by the organiser will **NOT** be refunded, unless agreed otherwise with the STS Office.

Prizes

- A Gold Medal will be awarded to the winner in each division.
- A Silver Medal will be awarded to the person placed 2nd in divisions of 4 or more athletes.
- A Bronze Medal will be awarded to the person placed 3rd in divisions of 5 or more athletes.
