FIRST STAGE: This is one of six venues for this event, details of which may be found by visiting www.nsra.co.uk

The first 20 shots at each distance will be used to determine the qualification for the Earl Haig Final and B,C,D Class Special Final. This will be held on Sunday 29th August at Denwood. Scottish qualified shooters will automatically be entered in the Earl Haig

PRIZES: Cash prizes will be awarded in all classes at the meeting; in addition to this, from each of these events the top three in each class will be invited to a free final on Saturday 11th September, again in classes X to D. There will also be a highest score final for the top forty scores selected from all regions on Sunday 12th September, both at Sywell Range again by invitation. Cash prizes will awarded in all classes and also the high score final.

SQUADDING: Choice per entry form below.

Squads will be of 2 details. All details will be of 20 minutes duration with 5 minutes between details and 15 minutes between squads for target changing and equipment preparation.

RECEPTION: On arrival, report for registration and collect targets & confirm squadding times.

RULES & RANGE SAFETY: All shooting will be governed by the NSRA rules. Any dispute will be decided by three or more members of the Range committee, or their elected deputies. Any uncased rifle must either have the bolt/action removed or a breach plug inserted at all times, except when firing a detail. Transgressors may be disqualified from the meeting at the discretion of the Range Committee.

TARGETS: NSRA MM12C-18 & 1001C 1996-18.

RESULTS: All scores will be displayed as quickly as possible. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure their scores are correctly recorded before leaving the meeting.

Incorporating the Qualifier for the Scottish Open Championship (The Earl Haig)

TIES will be decided on countback

CLASSIFICATION will be in 5 classes – X, A, B, C, and D per National classification. Unclassified competitors (those who did not complete an aggregate in an NSRA meeting in 2019) must submit an average based on the best 10 of their last 12 scores on NSRA (BM/89 Series) short range targets ex 100 or an average on 50m international/50yd NSRA proportional targets ex 600.

A	98.0 and above	580 and above
B	96.5 and under 98.0	570 and under 580
C	94.0 and under 96.5	560 and under 570
D	below 94.0	below 560

LIABILITY: ADSRA and Denwood RA will not accept any liability for loss or damage to property left on the range.

CHALLENGES: A score may be challenged on payment of £5.00, which will be refunded if the challenge is upheld.
